Do I need a passport and/or visa?

FOR U.S. AND CANADIAN CITIZENS: It is necessary for all passengers to provide proof of citizenship and photo ID in <u>one</u> of the following forms:

1) A current passport that is valid for at least six months after your return date, or

2) An original or certified copy of your birth certificate and valid photo ID (driver's license).

FOR NON-U.S./NON-CANADIAN CITIZENS: You must have and carry a passport valid for six months beyond the duration of your travel. Please carefully verify the existing identification requirements for your particular travel situation. For International passengers, please be sure you have the necessary Visas for travel if applicable. One online resource to quickly find out about visa requirements is http://www.visahq.com or you may contact the individual embassy for more info.

How much time do I need to allow for embarking and disembarking?

For air arrivals and departures into Seattle, it is recommended guests allow adequate time for transfer between the airport and pier, customs inspections and airport security checks. On the day of departure (August 13th) flights should arrive no later than 12:45 pm and on the day the ship returns (August 20th) flights should depart after 11:45 am.

Can I purchase transfers to/from the ship?

August 13th Transfer to the Ship

If you are arriving on the day of sailing, we can arrange for a Celebrity Cruise transfer from the airport directly to the pier for \$29.95 per person. You must arrive no later than 12:45 PM on August 13th into Seattle (SEA) Airport if you choose this option. It is mandatory that you provide the flight details to us when you make your transfer reservation. Reservations must be made by July 29th, 2021.

August 20th Transfer from the Ship

Life Journeys is offering Celebrity Cruise transfers to the airport on July 30th for \$29.95 per person. It is mandatory that you provide your flight information to us. Please be sure to schedule your departing flight out of Seattle (SEA) Airport after 11:45 AM on July 30th. Transfer information back to the airport will be given to you onboard the ship.

Taxis run approximately \$55-60 and are faster and about the same cost if more than one guest is traveling. You are about 40 minutes away from the ship terminal.

When may I embark the ship?

The Celebrity Millennium departs from Pier 91 at 4:00 pm. Embarkation begins at approximately 11:15 am, and guests are required to be on board no later than 90 minutes prior to sailing time. The Pier address is: 2001 W. Garfield St. Seattle, WA. For those driving, parking is available at Republic Parking at approximately \$26 per day. www.rpnw.com 206-783-4144, ext. 1113.

Pre and Post Hotel Options in Seattle

For those passengers who need airfare from the U.S., the Travel Edge Air Department can give you a free quote for the best fare and schedule. For those arriving early, downtown Seattle is located only about 15 minutes from the Port. There are many good discount internet sites available, such as <u>www.hotels.com</u> or <u>www.kayak.com</u>, both offering a variety of different-priced hotel options.

Dining room arrangements

Our group will have two dining options – Early dining (6:00 pm) and Late dining (8:30 pm), where you will be seated with other group members. Your selection will be noted on your confirmation letter. **If you have friends or family in other cabins that you are dining with you must inform us no later than July 16th in order to have those requests given to the ship. All requests must be in writing. For a buffet style restaurant, you can try the Oceanview Cafe which is complimentary, and the attire is casual. Room service is also available. Celebrity has enhanced the cruising experience for its guests in Suites (S2, S1, CS, RS) by adding a dining room for Suite guests only.** *Luminae* **is open for breakfast, lunch, and dinner and is not restricted to dining at a certain time each evening.**

Reservation-Only Specialty Restaurants

As delicious alternatives to the Main dining experience, you might consider one of the other restaurants on board the *Millennium*. Tuscan Grille is \$45, and Le Petit Chef @ Qsine is \$55. All prices are per person and require reservations.

Can the Dining Room accommodate special diets?

Watching your salt, fat or sugar intake? Lactose intolerant, celiac disease or vegan? Advise us at the time of booking, and we'll be happy to accommodate most dietary requirements. Kosher meals and special medical diets must be pre-ordered. All requests must be made in writing by e-mail to <u>special_needs@rccl.com</u> at least 90 days before sailing and must include your booking number and guest names. No request is necessary for vegetarian or gluten-free as options are plentiful onboard and a full vegetarian menu is available in the main dining room.

May I bring my own liquor On-Board?

No beer or hard liquor may be brought onboard for consumption. Guests wishing to bring personal wine or champagne with them may do so, limited to two bottles per stateroom. When consumed in the dining room they will be subject to a \$25 corkage fee.

Stateroom Amenities

All staterooms include safe, direct dial telephone, thermostat-controlled air-conditioning, mini-bar, bathroom accessories, hairdryers and remote controlled color TV. Staterooms are equipped with both North American standard 110-volt and European standard 220-volt outlets.

What's included in the cruise price?

- All meals, including room service from 6:00 am 11:00 pm, except in the specialty restaurants.
- Most entertainment, onboard activities, supervised kids' programs and fitness center
- FREE AMENITIES INSIDE, OCEAN VIEW, BALCONY, & CONCIERGE STATEROOMS ONLY
 - For all passengers in each Inside, Ocean View, Balcony & Concierge Class cabin, a FREE Classic Beverage package, Unlimited Surf Internet package, and FREE Gratuities have been included for our group. These amenities are valued at \$675 per person on this cruise. With this Beverage Package you can enjoy non-premium bottled water, premium coffees and teas, fresh and bottled juices, soda selections and wine-by-the glass* or your favorite cocktails*. Your package can be used throughout the ship.

* choose from beers up to \$6 per serving, spirits, cocktails, liqueurs and frozen drinks up to \$8 per serving, and wine-by-the-glass up to \$9 per serving. Plus, a 15% discount on all wines by the bottle purchased on board.

What's not included in the cruise price?

- Air Transportation or transfers to the ship
- Workshop fee of \$450 (billed separately by Life Journeys)
- Shore excursions in the various ports
- Alcoholic beverages**, soft drinks**, specialty coffees**, telephone or internet access service**, full service spa, beauty salon, fitness classes/personal trainer, babysitting, laundry/dry cleaning, photographs, casino gambling, gratuities** and late night room service (between 11:00 pm and 6:00 am, there is a \$4.95 fee per room service order. For our Suite Class guests, the late-night room service charge is waived).

**exceptions are covered by Free Amenities outlined above.

Ship Staff Gratuities/Tips

The standard gratuities for staff have been included as a free amenity for all passengers. This gratuity fee includes gratuities/tips for the stateroom steward, head waiter, waiter and assistant waiter.

Cruise Attire

Casual wear will be appropriate for days onboard. For evening wear, count on two basic types of attire.

- Smart Casual: dress, skirt, pants or jeans with a casual top for women; pants or jeans with a sport shirt that has sleeves for men
- Evening Chic: cocktail dress, skirt, pants or designer jeans with elegant top for women; pants or designer jeans with a dress shirt, button-down shirt or sweater, optional sport coat or blazer for men

There are two Evening Chic nights, one cocktail party, and the rest Smart Casual. No self-service laundry or ironing facilities are available. Full laundry services, including pressing, are available for a fee.

We're bringing the kids; any special activities for them?

Youth activities are directed and organized by a special staff of youth counselors. All programs offered onboard are subject to availability based on the number of children sailing. The ship may not be able to offer extended hours during the Abraham workshops.

When can I reserve my shore excursions?

You can pre-request your excursions with your booking number at <u>https://www.celebritycruises.com/pcp-reservation/find-your-reservation</u> or you can make your reservations when you board your ship – based upon availability. Pre-booking excursions is highly recommended! The last day to reserve shore excursions online is 4 days before sailing. Special group Abraham excursions may be offered by Celebrity and if possible, will be advised by end of June.

Ship Contact Information and Internet

Your final preparation email (E-docs) will contain detailed information including the phone number for your ship. The Internet Café is available, along with wireless internet throughout the ship when bringing your own devices. You can purchase internet packages based upon your needs. The unlimited internet package is approximately \$250.00 or you can purchase internet by the hour/day onboard the ship (see Free Amenities section above). The Internet Café is open 24 hours a day with ample computers.

Weather in Alaska

Expected temperatures can range from a low of 50° F (night) to a high of 75° F (day). Layered clothing is suggested, along with a folding umbrella in case of rain or mist. It is advisable to check the internet for up-to-date weather conditions prior to sailing. Bringing binoculars would also enhance viewing scenery.
